NL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



CENTRAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Complete English proposal
- Before the deadline! 28 May 17.00 CET!
- In electronic submission system
- Following template/rules (see GfA) (cut-off system!)
- Duration: small project: 6 m/ collaborative project 18–36 m





CONSORTIUM COMPOSITION

- 3 independent legal **organisations**
- from **3 AAL partner states** participating in this call
- who are **eligible** according to their own **national eligibility criteria**

- min. 1 commercial business partner
- min. 1 commercial SME
- min. 1 end user organization (i.c. 2 in collaborative projects)
- maximum of 10 partners





20% AND 50% RULES

Please be aware that:

- partners which have **more than 20%** of the Person Months in a project **can not be replaced** in case of reconfiguration!!!
- **≥50% of Person Months** should be carried out by business partners in collaborative projects



PARTNERS FROM NON-AAL COUNTRIES

Participation possible under following conditions

- EU member country
- They will not receive EU funding to match national/own contribution
- They can not have a crucial rule in the project
- They are not counted in the central eligibility criteria

NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- See: document **National Eligibility Criteria**
NB: some countries have several funding agencies!
- **CONTACT YOUR NCP's BEFORE SUBMISSION**
in some countries mandatory!!!

NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

NETHERLANDS / ZonMw

OBJECTIVES

The aims of NL to participate in AAL are to:

- Get AAL-solutions available on the NL market for use by older adults and their social/support networks - informal and professional
- Co-creation and testing/evaluating solutions by NL end users
- Broad commitment and interest in ICT innovations throughout the country

NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

NETHERLANDS / ZonMw

COLLABORATIVE PROJECTS

- 1 NL user organisation as potential ‘launching customer’
 - . Participates in pilots/field trials – considerable number of users
 - . NL user organisation in only 1 funded collaborative project
- 1 company ACTIVE in NL
 - . Serving NL market / supporting NL users (organisations)
- Max. budget €500.000 per project for NL partners

SMALL COLLABORATIVE PROJECTS

- Involvement of NL users (organisation), as partner/subcontracting
- Max. budget €100.000 per project

SMALL COLLABORATIVE PROJECTS

- Max. duration 6 months
- Max. budget € 300.000*
- Number of partners (min.3) proportionate to scope project
- Start in Q4 2018

- Shorter submission template
- Less reporting
- Shorter time to contract**

* not all countries will fund SMALL collaborative projects

** not all countries can guarantee a shorter time-to-contract
